## FALL GRANT APPLICATION: DUE SEPTEMBER 25, 2020



Founded in 1989, the Lake Tahoe Educational Foundation (LTEF) has dedicated itself to excellence in education by helping to support the educational programs and needs of the Lake Tahoe Unified School District in South Lake Tahoe, California. The Foundation is a public, non-profit organization run by a 21-member volunteer board with no overhead administrative costs. LTEF provides start-up funds to support new and innovative enrichment programs at all of the district schools. This is done through a fall season grant request process. LTEF has awarded over \$500,000 to our local schools in the past decade.

### Grants are funded once per year, in the fall. The application has two sections, A and B.

- **Section A**, the Program or Project Detail, asks for short specific grant details. This section requires no more than one half page to provide all of the requested information.
- **Section B**, the Program or Project Narrative, is the place to describe your program or project in two (2) pages or less. Please include:
  - the need you are trying to address
  - your anticipated project outcomes
  - what specifically the students' involvement will be
  - how you will measure the success of achieving your outcomes.
- **We require that you submit photographs, a slide show, and/or create and submit short video of your completed program or activity before the end of the 2020-2021 school year.**

- Please remember to have any students fill out the **photo/video waiver** form (available on our website) and maintain records of signed forms. Alternatively, you can include language in your program's promotional/registration material that states "by participation in this program, I give consent for my and/or my child's image to be used in video/photographic documentation of this program for LTEF promotional purposes."

### To assist you in filling out this application form, the funding criteria are listed below.

1. The program/project is a Lake Tahoe Unified School District sanctioned activity and you have received, and will provide to us, **written support from the school site principal** (if the proposal is **school specific**) **or the District administrator** (if the proposal is for a District wide activity).
2. The program/project advances LTUSD students' education.
3. The grant funds will be used for educational purposes and will **NOT** be used for volunteers, district professional staff stipends, or for general technology needs provided by the district (e.g. computers, phones, tablets, Ipads, or items in need of future maintenance).
4. The program/project serves a diversity of ages, school sites, interests, or a large number of LTUSD students.
5. **The requested amount does not exceed \$3000.**
